Types of AMBIS membership

Ordinary Members

- a. Persons who hold academic or professional qualifications in a recognized health field;
- b. Persons who do not hold academic or professional qualifications in a recognized health field but who have been employed in a recognized health field for an appropriate period; and
- c. Persons who do not hold academic or professional qualifications in a recognized health field but who have been professionals in the computer industry for an appropriate period and have shown interests in medical informatics.

Life Members

- a. Any person who has served as an Ordinary Member for 3 consecutive years shall be eligible for Life Membership on payment of a sum of \$200.
- b. Life members shall have full voting rights.

Student Members

- a. Full-time or part-time students at institutions in Singapore or overseas pursuing programmes leading to academic or professional qualifications in a recognised health field.
- b. Student members shall have no voting rights.

Honorary Members

- a. Persons, irrespective of their eligibility for Ordinary Membership of the Association, who are considered by the Executive Committee to have exceptional merit in furthering the aims and interests of the Association.
- b. Honorary members shall have no voting rights.

Corporate members

- a. Organizations with interests in medical informatics are eligible for Corporate membership.
- b. Each Corporate member can nominate a representative to the Association.
- c. The purpose of the Corporate membership is to provide interested organizations with an opportunity to support the Association in its activities in a meaningful way.
- d. Representatives of Corporate members shall have no voting rights.
